No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This proposal requires a two-year renewal of a retail sales tax license with the Department of Revenue. Any tax delinquencies including interest and penalties must be paid before a license can be renewed.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
