FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

In response to a similar proposal from this year (SB 884), officials from the **Department of Revenue** and the **Department of Economic Development** each assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **City of Kansas City**, **Jackson County** and the **Jackson County Sports Authority** did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes this proposal could result in a savings of sales tax revenue dedicated to improvements at the Jackson County Sports Authority. The municipality's Special Allocation Fund would not see the additional revenue from the sales tax for the sports stadium as a result of this proposal. Oversight assumes the sales tax revenue (between the Sports Authority and municipalities within Jackson County) will net to zero.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business
