ASSUMPTION

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

The proposal may have an administrative impact on small business pharmacies.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal revises the definition of "practice of pharmacy" to include the implementation of medical or veterinary prescription orders and prohibits any person other than the patient or the patient's authorized representative from accepting a dispensed prescription order unless that person is on the premises of a pharmacy.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
