No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This proposal officially ratifies the Equal Rights Amendment to the United States Constitution. Also, the proposal requests that a copy of the ratification be sent to the Archivist of the United States, the Vice-President of the United States, the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United States, and every member of the Missouri Congressional Delegation with a request that it be printed in the Congressional Record.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
