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DESCRIPTION

This proposal requires the Department of Health and Senior Services to provide the employee disqualification list to any school of nursing, school of medicine, or other health profession in order to determine whether students participating in patient care services are on the disqualification list. The list identifies individuals who have been determined by the department to have recklessly, knowingly, or purposely abused or neglected an in-home services or home health patient while employed by an in-home services provider or home health agency.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
