### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

## **DESCRIPTION**

#### <u>SECTION 361.711</u>

This proposal would affect the money order (sale of checks) law by clarifying the required amount of licensee's bonds and the purposes for which such bonds could be reached. The proposal also allows the Director of Finance to examine the books and records of such licensees (at the licensee's expense) when appropriate.

## **SECTION 361.715**

This section of the proposal authorizes the Director of Finance to do background investigations to determine applicants' fitness to be licensed and also authorizes a fee for amending licenses.

## **SECTION 362.275**

This section concerns bank reports which must be reviewed by a bank's directors to make more relevant information available to the board and to eliminate information that is no longer needed.

#### SECTION 362.445

This section of the proposal makes legal process on a bank consistent with the other provisions of civil procedure.

#### <u>SECTION 408.555</u>

The notice of default and right to cure law, is amended in subsection .3 to clarify the availability of three such formal notices on a 2nd deed of trust (rather than the two available in all other covered transactions). Subsection .4 is amended to include late charges and expenses of a foreclosure in the amount necessary to cure a default after time has run but before actual sale has been completed. The same subsection is amended to remove the criminal sanctions for a

wrongful foreclosure and is further amended to state that "only three defaults are permitted".

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
