FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Official from the **Missouri Gaming Commission**, **Department of Social Services** and the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Missouri Veterans Commission** assume this would result in an annual cost of \$250,000 to the Veterans Commission Capital Improvement Trust Fund.

According to the Department of Public Safety's budget request for 2007, the Veterans Service Officer Grants had the following expenditures in the recent past:

FY 2003 - \$573,137 FY 2004 - \$652,093 FY 2005 - \$726,577 FY 2006 - \$750,000 (appropriation)

Therefore, **Oversight** will assume that raising the annual appropriation from \$750,000 to \$1,000,000 will result in an increased expenditure from the Veterans Commission Capital Improvement Trust Fund of \$250,000 annually.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This proposal allows \$1 million in matching grants to be made annually for veterans' service officer programs by the Missouri Veterans Commission. The current limit is \$750,000.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
