DESCRIPTION

This bill allows the Highways and Transportation Commission to convey or exchange its interest in land or leasehold for the property's approximate fair market value. The commission, at its discretion, will be allowed to convey at no cost or exchange its interest in any land or leasehold that is no longer necessary for its use to any federal, state, or local governmental entity.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
