No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation allows a victim of statutory rape to terminate his or her parental rights to a child conceived as a result of statutory rape, upon a plea of guilt, conviction of statutory rape, or evidence establishing paternity.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
