FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal allows wineries, distillers, manufacturers, wholesalers, or brewers to provide or pour alcoholic beverages at no charge on their retail licensed premises for customer tasting purposes with a special permit or a by-the-drink license. The authorization is extended to off premises if no sales transactions take place. Solicitation for later sales does not constitute a violation of the prohibition.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
