### AN ACT

To amend chapter 565, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to transporting a child without parental consent, with a penalty provision.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 565, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 565.145, to read as follows:

**565.145. 1. A person commits the crime of transporting a child without parental  
2 consent if such person knowingly transports a child under the age of seventeen out of the  
3 state of Missouri, without the written consent of the child's parent or legal guardian, for  
4 one of the following purposes:**

5       **(1) To commit a crime with the child being the victim of that crime; or**

6       **(2) To commit a crime with the child being a participant in that crime.**

7       **2. Transporting a child without parental consent is a class C felony.**
