AN ACT

To repeal section 576.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to crime of bribery of a public servant, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 576.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 576.010, to read as follows:

576.010. 1. A person commits the crime of bribery of a public servant if he or she knowingly offers, confers or agrees to confer upon any public servant or candidate for public office, or a corresponding political campaign committee, or any political party committee or legislative caucus of which he or she is a member, or any members of a legislative caucus

- of which he or she is a member, any benefit, direct or indirect, in return for:
 (1) The recipient's official vote, support, opinion, appointment to public office,
- 7 **including any committee appointment,** recommendation, judgment, decision, action or 8 exercise of discretion as a public servant; or
- 9 (2) The recipient's violation of a known legal duty as a public servant.
- 2. It is no defense that the recipient was not qualified to act in the desired way because he **or she** had not yet assumed office, or lacked jurisdiction, or for any other reason.
 - 3. Bribery of a public servant is a class D felony.
