AN ACT

To amend chapter 143, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to computation of resident individual income.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 143, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 143.175, to read as follows:

143.175. 1. For all tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2006, a resident taxpayer shall be allowed to subtract from the taxpayer's Missouri adjusted gross income 2 to determine Missouri taxable income an amount equal to the amount of tax imposed on 3 the income of such taxpayer under section 3101 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 4 5 amended. 2. The director of revenue shall establish the procedure by which the deduction in 6 7 this section may be claimed, and shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, RSMo, 8 9 that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if

- 10 it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo, and, if
- 11 applicable, section 536.028, RSMo. This section and chapter 536, RSMo, are nonseverable
- 12 and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, RSMo,
- 13 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently

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14 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or

15 adopted after August 28, 2006, shall be invalid and void.

16 **3. Pursuant to section 23.253, RSMo, of the Missouri Sunset Act:**

(1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this section shall
automatically sunset six years after the effective date of this section unless reauthorized by
an act of the general assembly; and

(2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under this section
 shall automatically sunset twelve years after the effective date of the reauthorization of this
 section; and

(3) This section shall terminate on December thirty-first of the calendar year
immediately following the calendar year in which the program authorized under this
section is sunset.

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
