AN ACT

To amend chapter 571, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to prohibiting the sale of inappropriately colored firearms, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 571, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 571.027, to read as follows:

**571.027. 1. A person commits the crime of sale or distribution for sale of an
2 inappropriately colored firearm if such person knowingly sells or distributes for sale in this
3 state any inappropriately colored firearm.**

**4 2. As used in this section "inappropriately colored firearm" means any firearm as
5 defined in section 571.010, with a frame that is any color other than chrome, nickel, black
6 or blue steel.**

**7 3. Sale or distribution for sale of inappropriately colored firearm is a class A
8 misdemeanor.**
