AN ACT

To amend chapter 170, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to driver's education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 170, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 170.017, to read as follows:

170.017. Each high school as defined in section 160.011, RSMo, shall offer driver's
2 education courses at no cost to the student during each regular school year. Such courses
3 shall consist of classroom training and behind-the-wheel driver training, with each student
4 receiving at least twenty hours of classroom instruction and twenty hours of personal
5 driving experience. A successful completion of a course offered under this section shall
6 satisfy the driving experience requirements of subdivision (4) of subsection 1 of section
7 302.178, RSMo. Each instructor shall possess a driver's education endorsement on a
8 teaching certificate issued by the department of elementary and secondary education. No
9 student shall be permitted to operate a motor vehicle without an instruction permit issued
10 by the department of revenue under section 302.130, RSMo.
