## **AN ACT**

To repeal section 575.195, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to escape from commitment or detention, with a penalty provision and an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 575.195, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 575.195, to read as follows:

575.195. 1. A person commits the crime of escape from commitment or detention if he

- 2 or she has been committed to a state mental hospital under the provisions of **sections 202.700**
- 3 **to 202.770, RSMo, or of** sections 552.010 to 552.080, RSMo, or of sections 632.480 to 632.513,
- 4 RSMo, or has been ordered to be taken into custody, detained, or held pursuant to sections
- 5 632.480 to 632.513, RSMo, and he or she escapes from such commitment or detention.
- 6 2. Escape from commitment or detention is a class D felony.

Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to prevent the immediate danger posed

- 2 to the public from sexual predators escaping from mental institutions without penalty, section
- 3 A of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare,
- 4 peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the
- 5 constitution, and section A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and
- 6 approval.
