AN ACT

To amend chapter 10, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the designation of the official state invertebrate.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 10, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 10.125, to read as follows:

10.125. The crayfish, also called crawfish and crawdad, is selected for, and shall be
2 **known as, the official invertebrate of the state of Missouri.**

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
