HB 1245 -- School Nurses

Sponsor: Sater

This bill permits school nurses, upon authorization by the school board, to keep on hand and administer prefilled syringes of epinephrine in two dosage strengths. The nurse may administer the medication when, based on training, he or she believes a student is having an acute anaphylactic episode. The prescription must be written by a licensed physician listing the school district as the patient, as well as the nurse's name, and filled at a licensed pharmacy.
