HB 1316 -- Disarming a Peace or Correctional Officer

Sponsor: Lipke

This bill creates the crime of disarming a peace or correctional officer if a person intentionally removes from the peace or correctional officer or deprives the peace or correctional officer the use of his or her firearm or other deadly weapon while the officer is acting within the scope of his or her official duties. The crime, a class C felony, does not include situations in which the person does not know or could not reasonably have known that the person was a peace or correctional officer or if the officer was engaged in felonious conduct at the time of the disarmament.
