Reported from the Committee on Rules March 15, 2007 with recommendation that the bill Do Pass.

Taken up for Perfection April 4, 2007. Bill ordered Perfected and printed, as amended.

AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto seven new sections relating to the designation of a memorial highway.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto seven new sections, to be
2 known as sections 227.383, 227.384, 227.385, 227.388, 227.390, 227.392, and Section 1 to read
3 as follows:

227.383. The portion of highway 112 from the intersection of highway 76 south to
2 the intersection of highway AA in the county of the third classification without a township
3 form of government and with more than thirty-four thousand but fewer than thirty-four
4 thousand one hundred inhabitants, shall be designated the "Deputy Christopher Lee
5 Castetter Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain
6 appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid for by private
7 donations.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

227.384. The portion of State Route M between Old Lemay Ferry Road and Moss
2 Hollow Road in the census designated place with more than six thousand one hundred but
3 fewer than six thousand three hundred inhabitants shall be designated the "Officer
4 Stephen Strehl Memorial Highway". Costs for such designation shall be paid by private
5 donations.

227.385. The portion of U.S. Highway 61/67 between Wolf Hollow Road and State
2 Route M in the census designated place with more than six thousand one hundred but
3 fewer than six thousand three hundred inhabitants shall be designated the "1922 Sulphur
4 Springs Rail Disaster Memorial Highway". Costs for such designation shall be paid by
5 private donation.

227.388. The portion of highway 110 from U.S. highway 67 to highway 21 within
2 the county of the first classification with more than one hundred ninety-eight thousand but
3 fewer than one hundred ninety-nine thousand two hundred inhabitants shall be designated
4 the "DeSoto Railroad Employees Memorial Highway". Costs for such designation shall
5 be paid by private donations.

227.390. The portion of Interstate 44 from the city limits of the city not within a
2 county east to the intersection of Kingshighway shall be designated the "Officer Michael
3 Barwick Memorial Highway". Costs for such designation shall be paid by private
4 donation.

227.392 The new bridge carrying Interstate 29/35 over the Missouri River in the
2 home rule city with more than four hundred thousand inhabitants and located in more
3 than one county shall be designated the "Christopher S. Bond Bridge". Costs for such
4 designation shall be paid by private donation.

Section 1. The portion of State Route 7 from the south edge of the city limits of a
2 home rule city with more than forty-eight thousand but fewer than forty-nine thousand
3 inhabitants heading south to the intersection of US Highway 50 shall be designated the
4 "Larry Stewart Secret Santa Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall
5 erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid
6 for by private donation.
