## AN ACT

To amend chapter 8, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to designation of a certain state building.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 8, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 8.912, to read as follows:

**8.912. The state office building for the department of agriculture located at 1616**  
2 **Missouri Boulevard in Jefferson City shall be designated as the "George Washington**  
3 **Carver Building" in honor of George Washington Carver who was a trailblazer in the field**  
4 **of agricultural science, technology, and philanthropy.**
