### AN ACT

To repeal section 253.095, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to park services.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 253.095, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 253.095, to read as follows:

253.095. In order to further the interpretive or educational functions of Missouri state parks, the director of the Missouri department of natural resources is authorized to enter into agreements with private, not-for-profit organizations that are organized [solely] to provide cooperative, interpretive, **facility enhancement** or educational services to any [one] Missouri state park. The director may provide state park facility space **and incidental staff support** to such an organization under a cooperative agreement, **which reimburses the department for the actual costs of such space and incidental staff support and clearly demonstrates the fiscal, interpretive, educational, and facility enhancement benefits to the state.** Net proceeds received from the sale of publications or other materials **and services** provided by an organization pursuant to such an agreement entered into under this section shall be retained by the organization for use in the interpretive or educational services provided [to such park that the
