### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Veterans' Commission** and the **Department of Revenue** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Missouri Gaming Commission** state there are currently 418 regular bingo licensees, 177 of which are veterans groups (approximately 42%). The approximate bingo face tax collected for FY 2006 of \$1,652,000 x 42% is \$693,840, which for the purposes of this fiscal note will be rounded to \$694,000. This would be a reduction in funding to schools if the veterans groups were exempted. FY 2008 shown as approximately \$578,000 to account for only 10 months assuming the law would not be in effect until sometime in August.

**Oversight** will reflect the reduced revenue to the Bingo Proceeds for Education Fund. However, this loss of revenue could also be reflected at the local school districts.

### This proposal could reduce Total State Revenues.

## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

## FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Currently, all bingo card suppliers must pay a tax equal to two-tenths of one cent on each bingo card sold in Missouri. This bill exempts veterans' organizations from this tax.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
