FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Coordinating Board for Higher Education** stated this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

According to officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DES)**, the proposal will result in minimal impact to school districts depending on the number of students enrolling at any one time. If a substantial number of students vacated a particular non-accredited school and enrolled in the same accredited school, there would be major impact for the 30-day time period. However, in general, districts will be impacted in the form of minimal personnel time. DES indicated there would be no fiscal impact to their agency.

A request for fiscal note response was sent to several school districts, none of which responded.
