FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture** assume no fiscal impact to their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Conservation (MDC)** assume this proposal would have a fiscal impact on MDC funds, since it would invalidate MDC's ability to regulate captive-reared game bird wildlife. The loss of revenue could result if lack of any standards or oversight leads to introduction of diseases or other wildlife management challenges. The proposal impinges on the authority of the Conservation Commission to manage the bird, fish, forest, and wildlife resources of Missouri.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
