FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Higher Education (DHE)** assume this legislation will have no direct fiscal impact for the DHE because the Missouri higher education savings program board is not controlled by the DHE. It does indicate that the Missouri higher education savings program board shall be responsible for administering the fund, however, it should be noted that the board does not have any administrative staff under its direct control.

Officials at the **Missouri State University (MSU)** assume this legislation should have a positive impact on Universities by providing additional financial assistance to students. MSU cannot predict the extent of funds that might transfer from the abandoned account, and thus cannot predict the additional aid that might be made available to assist students.

Officials at the **Office of the State Treasurer, Lincoln University, Linn State Technical College, University of Central Missouri, University of Missouri** and the **Metropolitan Community College** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective institutions from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
