FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the Office of Secretary of State- Elections Division assume no fiscal impact.

The **City Administrator of West Plains** stated this proposal could have a positive fiscal impact in election costs savings. Officials estimate savings from \$1500 to more than \$3000.

The **City Administrator of the City of Centralia** stated any savings would be unpredictable, however, not having to have an election could save the city as much as \$2000.

Officials of the **Platte County Board of Elections Commission** assume no fiscal impact to the commission.

Officials of the **Clay County Board of Elections Commission** assume no fiscal impact to their commission, however, officials assume cities could possibly have significant savings from not having to hold elections under certain circumstances.

Officials of the City of Pacific made only a comment. No fiscal impact estimate was issued.

Oversight assumes there would be election cost savings to those cities that would not have to hold an election due to the number of positions to be filled equaling the number of candidates that have filed for the position. **Oversight** would expect any savings that might be realized to be minimal and assume that not every city election would realize savings.

Oversight assumes that not all cities would realize at each election an election cost savings.

Oversight has no way to estimate what cities might have savings, or the amount of savings.

Oversight cannot determine the number of positions that might produce savings.

Oversight will show fiscal impact to cities as \$0 or minimal.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill allows third and fourth class cities, towns, and villages to cancel an election if the number of candidates who file for the position is equal to the number of positions to be filled.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
