### FISCAL ANALYSIS

# ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Missouri Department of Conservation** (**MDC**) assume this proposed legislation would have fiscal impact on MDC funds as there would be administrative changes necessary, both within the agency and at each permit vender, for implementation of a process for selling permits without hunter education certification. Exact impacts are unknown but could exceed \$100,000. Hunter education training is unlike military firearms training with different impacts and applications.

Officials at the **Missouri Veterans Commission** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

**Oversight** assumes that there would be a fiscal impact on MDC funds from the administrative changes that would be needed to issue a permit. This fiscal impact is unknown.
