ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on local school districts.

In response to the introduced version of this proposal, officials from the **Sullivan School District**, **Fair Grove School District**, and the **Marshfield R-I School District** responded to a request for fiscal note.
