#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

According to officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)**, at this time the federal government has not released the final rules and regulations to states outlining REAL ID requirements. At this time, Missouri is not aware of any potential federal fund withholdings for lack of compliance with REAL ID. DOR is not able to speculate on outcomes not knowing what rules and regulation requirements might be.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DOHSS)** state that whether the Real ID Act is adopted or not has no real impact on DOHSS. Currently, most Missourians need a certified copy of their birth certificate to receive a driver's license (Lawful Presence - SB 1233--2004). Refusing to comply with the Real ID Act would not impact the requirements imposed by SB 1233. DOHSS shows no fiscal impact to their agency.
