#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DES)** state there is no fiscal impact to their agency. DES assumes school districts will likely experience an undetermined cost for the development and distribution of their plans.

**Oversight** assumes development and distribution of emergency plans can be absorbed with existing resources. **Oversight** notes that practice for the implementation plan, which may include "a scenario rehearsal" is permissive and assumes it can be accomplished without disrupting the school schedule, resulting in little or no fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Mexico School District** state this proposal has no significant fiscal impact for day to day operations. There could be a reasonable fiscal impact during a state of emergency.
