FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial and Professional Regulation (DIFP)** state the proposal revises laws relating to the licensing of social workers. There are three levels of social workers added - the licensed advanced macro social worker, the licensed baccalaureate social worker, and the licensed master social worker. It is assumed that the licensing fees will offset any costs incurred by the board. The DIFP assumes the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Office of Secretary of State (SOS)** state the fiscal impact for this proposal is less than \$2,500. The SOS does not expect that additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, the SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed by the General Assembly in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the SOS can sustain within its core budget. Therefore, the SOS reserves the right to request funding for the costs of supporting administrative rules requirements should the need arise based on a review of the finally approved bills signed by the Governor.

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** did not respond to our request for a statement of fiscal impact.
