ASSUMPTION

Officials at the Metropolitan Community College, Department of Higher Education, Linn State Technical College, University of Central Missouri and the Missouri Highway Patrol assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Lincoln University** assume minimal cost to the school in work hours and reprinting of applications.

Oversight assumes that any costs to the Colleges and Universities to change the student housing application can be absorbed with existing resources. Additionally, Oversight assumes that since this proposal allows the Colleges and Universities to collect a fee to cover the cost of performing the check that there would be no cost to state funds from this proposal.
