AN ACT

To amend chapter 589, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a registry for
methamphetamine offenders.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 589, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 589.480, to read as follows:

**589.480. 1. The Missouri state highway patrol shall, subject to appropriation,
2 create, and make available for public inquiry on the Internet a registry of any person who
3 is a resident of this state and who on or after August 28, 2007, is convicted of, found guilty
4 of, pleads guilty to, or who is granted a suspended imposition of sentence for committing
5 or attempting to commit one or more of the following offenses: distribution, delivery,
6 manufacture, or production of a controlled substance under section 195.211, RSMo,
7 unlawful distribution to a minor under section 195.213, RSMo, distribution of a controlled
8 substance near schools under section 195.214, RSMo, distribution of a controlled substance
9 near public housing under section 195.218, RSMo, trafficking drugs in the first degree
10 under section 195.222, RSMo, trafficking drugs in the second degree under section 195.223,
11 RSMo, unlawfully providing materials for production of a controlled substance under
12 section 195.226, RSMo, distribution of a controlled substance in violation of registration
13 requirements under subdivisions (1) and (2) of subsection 1 of section 195.252, RSMo,**

14 when such offense involves methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers,
15 or a methamphetamine precursor drug as defined in section 195.010, RSMo.

16 2. The registry shall consist of the person's name, date of birth, offense or offenses
17 making the person eligible for inclusion on the registry, the date the person was convicted,
18 found guilty, pled guilty to or was granted a suspended imposition of sentence for the
19 offense or offenses, the county of the offense or offenses, and other identifying data as the
20 Missouri highway patrol determines is necessary to properly identify the person, but shall
21 not include the person's Social Security number.

22 3. Beginning August 28, 2007, the clerk of the court in which the person was
23 convicted, found guilty, pled guilty, or was granted a suspended imposition of sentence
24 shall forward a copy of the judgment and date of birth of all persons who are convicted of,
25 found guilty of, plead guilty to or who were granted a suspended imposition of sentence for
26 a violation of an offense making the person eligible for inclusion on the registry to the
27 Missouri state highway patrol within forty-five days of the date of judgment.

28 4. The Missouri state highway patrol shall remove from the registry the name and
29 other identifying information of persons who are convicted of, found guilty of, plead guilty
30 to, or who are granted a suspended imposition of sentence for a violation of an offense
31 making the person eligible for inclusion on the registry seven years after the date of the
32 most recent judgment which would require inclusion on the registry.

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
