AN ACT

To amend chapter 566, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to restrictions on certain sexual offenders, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 566, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 566.150, to read as follows:

**566.150 1. Any person who has pleaded guilty to, or been convicted of, or been
2 found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this chapter or the provisions of
3 subsection 2 of section 568.020, RSMo, incest; section 568.045, RSMo, endangering the
4 welfare of a child in the first degree; subsection 2 of section 568.080, RSMo, use of a child
5 in a sexual performance; section 568.090, RSMo, promoting a sexual performance by a
6 child; section 573.023, RSMo, sexual exploitation of a minor; section 573.025, RSMo,
7 promoting child pornography; or section 573.040, RSMo, furnishing pornographic
8 material to minors; shall not:**

9 **(1) Be present in or loiter within five hundred feet of any real property comprising
10 any public park or public swimming pool; or**

11 **(2) Serve as an athletic coach, manager, or athletic trainer for any sports team in
12 which a child younger than twelve years of age is a member.**

13 **2. Violation of the provisions of this section shall be a class A misdemeanor.**
