AN ACT

To repeal section 50.332, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to county officers performing duties for municipalities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 50.332, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 50.332, to read as follows:

50.332. Each county officer in all counties except first class counties having a charter form of government may, subject to the approval of the governing body of the county, contract with the governing body of any municipality located within such county, either in whole or in part, to perform the same type of duties for such municipality as such county officer is performing for the county. Any compensation paid by a municipality for services rendered pursuant to this section shall be paid directly to the county[, or county officer, or both, as provided in the provisions of the contract, and any compensation allowed any county officer under any such contract may be retained by such officer in addition to all other compensation provided by law].
