### AN ACT

To amend chapter 484, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to allowing attorneys to provide legal services to needy persons without compensation.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 484, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 484.280, to read as follows:

**484.280. Any provision of law, rule, regulation, or policy that requires a public  
2 official or employee to devote his or her full time to their office, or that prohibits a public  
3 official or employee from engaging in the practice of law outside of his or her official  
4 duties, shall not prohibit an official or employee who is licensed to practice law in this state  
5 from providing legal services to needy persons if such services are provided without  
6 compensation.**
