AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to ethical vaccines.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 191.1000, to read as follows:

191.1000. 1. As used in this section, the term "ethical vaccine" means any vaccine that is not produced using any cell culture derived from an aborted fetus.

- 2. Beginning January 1, 2008, the state of Missouri shall not purchase or pay for any vaccine that is not an ethical vaccine; except that, if there is no ethical vaccine available for a particular disease or condition, a vaccine that does not meet the definition of ethical vaccine in this section may be used.
- 3. After January 1, 2010, the state of Missouri shall not purchase or reimburse for any vaccine unless it is an ethical vaccine.
- 4. Any parent or legal guardian of a child and any adult given a vaccine that is not an ethical vaccine shall be informed that the vaccine was manufactured using a cell culture derived from an aborted fetus.
- 5. Any person may refuse to receive a vaccine based on a religious objection, including but not limited to any objection on the grounds that there is no ethical vaccine available for a specific disease or condition.
