AN ACT

To amend chapter 143, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to an income tax deduction.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 143, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 143.125, to read as follows: 2 143.125. 1. As used in this section, "taxpayer" means any resident individual: 2 (1) Who is sixty-five years of age or older; 3 (2) Whose federal adjusted gross income is eighty-nine thousand dollars or less; 4 and 5 (3) Who receives Social Security benefits, receives reduced Social Security benefits, or receives no Social Security benefits because such individual participates in a privately 6 7 funded annuity, pension, or retirement system. 8 2. For all taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2007, any taxpayer shall 9 be allowed to subtract from the taxpayer's Missouri adjusted gross income to determine Missouri taxable income an amount equal to the amount of any Social Security benefits 10

- 11 received by the taxpayer or the amount of any retirement allowance received from any
- 12 privately funded source and that are included in federal adjusted gross income under
- 13 Section 86 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

14 3. The director of the department of revenue may promulgate rules to implement 15 the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, RSMo, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall 16 become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 17 536, RSMo, and, if applicable, section 536.028, RSMo. This section and chapter 536, 18 19 RSMo, are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, RSMo, to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and 20 21 annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking 22 authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2007, shall be invalid and 23 void.

4. Under section 23.253, RSMo, of the Missouri sunset act:

(1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this section shall
automatically sunset six years after the effective date of this section unless reauthorized by
an act of the general assembly; and

(2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under this section
shall automatically sunset twelve years after the effective date of the reauthorization of this
section; and

(3) This section shall terminate on December thirty-first of the calendar year
immediately following the calendar year in which the program authorized under this
section is sunset.
