AN ACT

To amend chapter 171, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to open enrollment.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 171, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 171.035, to read as follows:

**171.035. No school district with any territory contained in a county declared to be
2 a federal disaster area on January 16, 2007, that cancelled classes or dismissed classes early
3 for weather-related reasons for any of its schools for any days from January 15 to January
4 22, 2007, shall be required to make up the days or hours lost during such time. The
5 requirement for scheduling two-thirds of the missed days into the next year's calendar
6 under subsection 1 of section 171.033 shall be waived for the 2007-08 school year.**
