AN ACT

To repeal section 173.239, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to military scholarships.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 173.239, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 173.239, to read as follows:

173.239. 1. Any member of the Missouri national guard, the United States Army 2 Reserve, United States Air Force Reserve, United States Navy Reserve, United States Marine Reserve, United States Coast Guard Reserve, or the United States Public Health 3 4 Service Reserve, who possesses the qualifications set forth in this section may be awarded an 5 educational assistance grant to an approved public institution or an approved private institution, 6 as those terms are defined in either section 173.205 or section 173.778, of his or her choice while he or she is a member of the Missouri national guard, the United States Army Reserve, United 7 States Air Force Reserve, United States Navy Reserve, United States Marine Reserve, 8 9 United States Coast Guard Reserve, or the United States Public Health Service Reserve. Funding for educational assistance pursuant to this section may be requested annually in the 10 11 budget of the Missouri national guard. Educational assistance provided pursuant to this section 12 shall not exceed funds appropriated for that purpose. 13 2. Educational assistance provided under this section shall not exceed the least of the following: 14

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(1) The actual tuition, as defined in section 173.260, charged at an approved institutionwhere the individual is enrolled or accepted for enrollment; or

17 (2) The amount of tuition charged a Missouri resident at the University of Missouri for18 attendance;

(3) The grants provided under this section may be prorated subject to appropriations inan amount no less than fifty percent of the limits set forth in this section.

21 3. A member of the Missouri national guard, the United States Army Reserve, United 22 States Air Force Reserve, United States Navy Reserve, United States Marine Reserve, 23 United States Coast Guard Reserve, or the United States Public Health Service Reserve, 24 seeking educational assistance pursuant to this section shall provide a certificate of satisfactory 25 service of his or her Missouri national guard, the United States Army Reserve, United States 26 Air Force Reserve, United States Navy Reserve, United States Marine Reserve, United States Coast Guard Reserve, or the United States Public Health Service Reserve, duties 27 28 from his or her commanding officer and shall possess all other necessary entrance requirements 29 of the school of his or her choice and shall maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 30 at least two point five on a four point scale, or the equivalent on another scale approved by the 31 program administrator, while attending the approved public or private institution.

32 4. If the grade point average of a member who is receiving educational assistance 33 pursuant to this section falls below two point five on a four point scale, or the equivalent on 34 another scale, such member shall retain the educational assistance and shall be placed on 35 probation under the educational assistance program. Failure to achieve a current grade point average of at least two point five on a four point scale or the equivalent on another scale for 36 37 future semesters or equivalent academic terms shall result in termination of the scholarship 38 effective as of the next academic term. The member shall be removed from probation status 39 upon achieving a cumulative grade point average of two point five on a four point scale or the 40 equivalent on another scale.

41 5. If a recipient of educational assistance pursuant to this section ceases to [maintain their active military affiliation] be a member of the Missouri National Guard, the United 42 43 States Army Reserve, United States Air Force Reserve, United States Navy Reserve, United States Marine Reserve, United States Coast Guard Reserve, or the United States Public 44 45 Health Service Reserve, while enrolled in an academic semester or term for any reason except 46 death, disability, or medical disqualification the educational assistance shall be terminated and 47 the recipient shall repay any amounts awarded for the academic semester or term. 48 Applicants for educational assistance pursuant to this section shall meet the 6.

qualifications established by section 173.215, except the provisions of subdivisions (2) and (4)
of subsection 1 of section 173.215, and shall be qualified, full-time or part-time students.

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51 7. The educational assistance program established pursuant to this section shall be 52 administered by the office of the adjutant general of the Missouri national guard. The Missouri 53 national guard shall establish guidelines for equitable administrative distribution of educational 54 assistance.

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
