### AN ACT

To repeal section 198.097, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to failure to pay for nursing home care, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 198.097, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 198.097, to read as follows:

198.097. 1. Any person who assumes the responsibility of managing the financial affairs
of an elderly person who is a resident of a nursing home [shall be] is guilty of a class D felony
if such person misappropriates the funds and fails to pay for the nursing home care of the elderly
person.

5 2. It shall be evidence of misappropriating funds and failing to pay for the nursing
6 home care of an elderly person if:

7 (1) The nursing home sends written notification of failure to pay nursing home
8 expenses incurred by an elderly resident to the person who has assumed responsibility of
9 managing the financial affairs of the elderly person;

10 (2) The nursing home does not receive payment within thirty days of such person 11 receiving actual notice in writing for the first time and the nursing home sends a second 12 written notification of failure to pay nursing home expenses;

- 13 (3) The nursing home does not receive payment within thirty days of such person
- 14 receiving actual notice in writing for the second time and the nursing home sends a third

15 and final written notification of failure to pay nursing home expenses; and

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(4) The nursing home does not receive payment within thirty days of such person
 receiving actual notice in writing for the third and final time.

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19 As used in this subsection, "actual notice in writing" means notice of the nonpayment

- 20 which is actually received by the person who has assumed responsibility of managing the
- 21 financial affairs of an elderly person. Such notice may include, but shall not be limited to,

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22 notice by certified mail, return receipt requested.
