## **AN ACT**

To repeal section 575.353, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the crime of assault on a police animal, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 575.353, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 575.353, to read as follows:

575.353. 1. A person commits the crime of assault on a police animal when such person

- 2 knowingly attempts to kill or disable or knowingly causes or attempts to cause serious physical
- 3 injury to a police animal when that animal is involved in law enforcement investigation,
- apprehension, tracking, or search, or the animal is in the custody of or under the control of a law
- 5 enforcement officer, department of corrections officer, municipal police department, fire
- department or a rescue unit or agency.
  - 2. Assault on a police animal is a class [C misdemeanor] **D felony**.
