2 3	on a runway in Detroit, Michigan, for an excessive amount of time; and
4 5	Whereas, in December 2006 an American Airlines flight was delayed on a runway in Austin, Texas, for eight to nine hours; and

7 8	Whereas, on February 14, 2007, a JetBlue Airways flight was delayed on a runway in New York, New York, for eleven hours; and

10 11 12	Whereas, passengers on all of these grounded flights were not allowed to leave the airplane; and
13	Whereas, passengers trapped on these grounded flights were subject to
14 15	deteriorating conditions such as lack of food and potable water, and bathrooms that quit working:
16	Now, therefore, be it resolved that the members of the House of
17	Representatives of the Ninety-fourth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate
18	concurring therein, hereby urge Congress to enact the "Airline Passenger Bill of Rights Act of
19	2007", House Bill No. 1303 and Senate Bill No. 678, or similar legislation, to protect airline
20 21	customers; and
22	Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
23	Representatives be instructed to prepare properly inscribed copies of this resolution for each

24 member of the Missouri Congressional Delegation.
