ANACT

To repeal section 173.425, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to student loan administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 173.425, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu

thereof, to be known as section 173.425, to read as follows: 173.425. The proceeds of all bonds or other forms of indebtedness issued by the

- authority and of all fees permitted to be charged by the authority and of other revenues derived
- 3 shall not be considered to be part of the revenue of the state within the meaning of article III,
- section 36, of the Constitution of Missouri, shall not be required to be deposited into the state
- treasury, and shall not be subject to appropriation by the general assembly. All proceeds, fees,
- and revenues shall only be used for administering student loans, lowering student loan
- rates, forgiving student loans, issuing student loans, and for the proper administration of the authority. The proceeds, fees, and revenue shall remain under the exclusive control and
- management of the authority to be used as required pursuant to sections 173.350 to 173.450.
- Student loan notes purchased or financed shall not be considered to be public property.
