

HB 213 -- Intellectual Diversity in Public Higher Education

Sponsor: Cunningham (86)

This bill establishes the "Emily Brooker Intellectual Diversity Act," which defines intellectual diversity for reporting purposes at public higher education institutions. The Coordinating Board for Higher Education will require, as of December 31, 2008, an annual report describing steps taken by each institution to ensure intellectual diversity, which will be posted on the institution's web site. Students must be notified that measures are in place to promote intellectual diversity and how to report alleged violations of institutional policy.
