#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture**, **Department of Public Safety - Office of Director and Missouri State Highway Patrol**, **Department of Conservation**, and the **Department of Revenue** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources** assume they will incur a cost of \$5,600 for 100 helmets for their 56 utility vehicles.

**Oversight** assumes this cost can be absorbed with existing resources.
