ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Transportation, St. Louis County, and the City of Centralia assume there would be no fiscal impact to their organizations from this proposal.

Officials from the **Office of Administration**, **Division of Budget and Planning** assumed that a previous version of this proposal would not result in additional costs or savings to their organization as a result of this proposal.

Officials from **Clinton County** assume this proposal could result in reductions in revenues to schools and to the county road fund.

Oversight assumes that any transportation development district created as a result of this proposal would be funded by additional dedicated sales tax revenues and would have no fiscal impact to other local governments.
