#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials of the **Department of Natural Resources** assume no fiscal impact to their department.

**Oversight** assumes that current law provides that only owners of 25% of the property in certain drainage districts can petition a court for re-adjustment of the assessment of benefits for the property in the district. This bill allows the district board of supervisors to petition for re-adjustment for some or all of the property in the district as identified in the petition. **Oversight** assumes this proposal as written is procedural and does not require boards to seek readjustment of benefit assessments in their districts.

**Oversight** assumes local boards would have to act before fiscal impact would be realized. **Oversight** assumes no state or local fiscal impact.
