AN ACT

To appropriate money for the expenses, grants, refunds, and distributions of the Department of Mental Health, the Board of Public Buildings, the Department of Health and Senior Services, and the several divisions and programs thereof, the Missouri Health Facilities Review Committee to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, for the period beginning July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri for the purpose of funding each department, division, agency, and program enumerated in each section for the item or items stated, and for no other purpose whatsoever chargeable to the fund designated for the period beginning July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009, as follows:

4 or below 200 percent of Federal Poverty Level, consisting of 5 services or counseling offered to a pregnant woman and continuing 6 for one year thereafter, to assist her in carrying her unborn child to 7 term instead of having an abortion, and to assist her in caring for 8 her dependent child or placing her child for adoption, including, 9 but not limited to the following: prenatal care; medical and mental 10 health care; parenting skills; drug and alcohol testing and 11 treatment; child care; newborn or infant care; housing utilities; 12 educational services; food, clothing, and supplies relating to 13 pregnancy, newborn care, and parenting; adoption assistance; job 14 training and placement; establishing and promoting responsible paternity; ultrasound services; case management; domestic abuse 15 16 protection; and transportation. None of these funds 21 shall be expended to perform or induce, assisting the performing 22 or inducing of, or refer for, abortions; and none of these funds 23 shall be granted to organizations or affiliates of organizations that
